God's call to urgency

THE COMING ANTICHRIST

Here are some of the coming events as we see them from scripture:

1. The Rapture.
2. People that are left behind panic and the world is in chaos.
3. The Antichrist comes forth.
4. A covenant (or treaty) is confirmed by the Antichrist with Israel (and others).
5. The beginning of the Tribulation of seven years, which is divided into two parts.
6. Russia and other nations invade Israel.
7. God defends Israel and destroys most of the invading force.

The presence of the church, or the presence of the Holy Spirit in the saints, appears to hold back the Antichrist from coming forth. The Word of God holds back the Antichrist from coming forth until the appointed time.

2 Thessalonians 2:3-10 Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; 4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God. 5 Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? 6 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time. 7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [will let], until he be taken out of the way. 8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 9 [Even him], whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

The first prophecy is in Daniel Chapter 7

Daniel is an amazing book of history and prophecy. God gave Daniel detailed visions of the end times. These do require careful interpretations. But, it is clear that Daniel 7, vs 7,8, and 20 speak of the Antichrist.

Daniel 7:7-8 After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it [was] diverse from all the beasts that [were] before it; and it had ten horns. 8 I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn [were] **eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.**

Daniel 7:20 And of the ten horns that [were] in his head, and [of] the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even [of] that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, **whose look [was] more stout than his fellows.**

What do "eyes of man" mean? This is a Hebrew idiom for a person's intellect. The Antichrist will be a brilliant man with nearly supernatural mental powers. He will have great oratory skills. With these two tools, he will persuade the world to follow him. The Antichrist will be a leader like no one else. "more stout than his fellow" is the way Daniel compares him to all other leaders. In Revelation 7:13b we read: **and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.** And in Revelation 13:3b: "the whole world was astonished and followed after the beast." (NIV)

The Antichrist will come from the reconstituted Roman Empire, the European Union.

There are two great visions found in Daniel that describe the empires of his world and the world to come. The first is the Statue in King Nebuchadnezzar's dream:

Daniel 2:32-34 This image's head [was] of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, 33 His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay. 34 Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet [that were] of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.

And the second in Daniel Chapter 7:

Daniel 7:2-8 Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea. 3 And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another. 4 The first [was] like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it. 5 And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and [it had] three ribs in the mouth of it between the

teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh. 6 After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it. 7 After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it [was] diverse from all the beasts that [were] before it; and it had ten horns. 8 I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn [were] eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.

The head of gold and the lion represent the Babylonian Empire, The breast of silver and the bear represent the Medo-Persian Empire. The belly of brass and the leopard represent the Grecian empire. And the legs of iron and the "fourth beast, dreadful and terrible" represent the Roman Empire. The feet of the statue represent the reconstituted Roman Empire, made up of a coalition of parts,

Looking back at Daniel 7-8, the sea is emblematic of humanity. The horn speaks of strength and honor. It is a means of attack and defense and , therefore authority.

The Antichrist will become the False Messiah

Initially the world will hail the anti-Christ as a political savior that will bring about world peace. However, three-and-a-half years after the enactment of the seven-year peace accord between Israel and the Arab nations, he will become jealous of the world's attention focused on Israel after she reinstated the sacrifices to God, and will bring an end to the peace accord, stop the animal sacrifices by the Jews in the Temple, and demand that all attention and worship be directed toward himself. The anti-Christ ruler will then use international and Arab military forces at his disposal to invade Israel in order to establish Jerusalem as his world capital.

He will then cause an image of himself to be empowered to speak and "cause those who refuse to worship it to be killed"

Revelation 13:14-15 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by [the means of] those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live. 15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Jesus warned us that when we see this image, the "abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (temple) ... then shall be great tribulation such as has not been since the beginning of the world" (Matthew 24:15,21). At this time the Beast and his followers will bring about a time of horror through great persecution of believers in God

The Antichrist will be possessed by Satan

Where does the Antichrist get his power?

Revelation 13:1-5 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. 2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as [the feet] of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: **and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.** 3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast. 4 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who [is] like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him? 5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty [and] two months.

The "dragon" is, of course, none other than Satan. The Apostle Paul speaks of the basis for the "lawless one's" power.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-10 [Even him], whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Satan's plan is to destroy those who believe in Christ

The saved (Saints, not Ain't's) are removed. But Satan will demand worship and he will try to destroy anyone that does not worship him and who have chosen to worship the one true God.

Revelation 13:6-8 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven. 7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. 8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Who will be the Antichrist?

Of course we have no way of knowing. However, there are some intriguing events occurring, event today. Tony Blair, former prime minister of Great Britain, says that he will be the president of Europe if they give him the power. As the European Union (EU) prepares to name the first permanent president of the member states, one name keeps surfacing as the very first European president, Tony Blair. French President Sarkozy, German Chancellor Merkel, Gordon Brown (current Prime Minister Great Britain), and even US President George W. Bush have suggested Tony Blair would make a great president of Europe. In response to these suggestions, Tony Blair has said that he is increasingly willing to put himself forward for the job **if it comes with real power to make a difference**. Tony Blair's current job is the Middle East Peace Envoy for the Quartet. The Quartet is a national consortium consisting of the United States, the European Union, the United Nations and Russia. Blair has an office in Jerusalem where he has been playing a major role in the Israeli-Palestinian peace process.

While, I do not think that Tony Blair is the Antichrist, I do think that his influence on the EU will set up the position for the Man of Perdition to ascend to. Is the Antichrist alive today? I believe he is. Has he taken power, yet? It is clear he has not, but if the world is ripe for this ruler, it can't be much longer. Is there anyone who fits the description of the man of lawlessness in the forefront of politics today? Is there anyone you believe could follow the pattern listed above? I think the world will find out in the near future, except for those gathered to the Lord in the in the Rapture.

Based on all that we have studied this is what we know or think we know about the Antichrist:

He will come up from a normal background, not from wealth or promise, and will be street savvy among the impoverished, though the rich will see a great king in his simple elegance as he most assuredly will be the prince of political correctness and the troubadour of political poetry . His intelligence level will be quietly genius and calculated, and he will be persuasive in his speech and demeanor.

He will have the oratory skills of a Martin Luther King, the vitality of a John F. Kennedy, the spiritual prominence of Gandhi and the social ecumenism of Mother Teresa. In his heart the hatred and narcissism of Adolf Hitler will squirm. He will be calm and as a chameleon, he will change his color to fit his surroundings. He will be a shape-shifter, coolly adapting to the changing tides and as smooth as Teflon with regard to them that oppose him. His ability to plan, organize and manipulate all things in his grasp will be greater than any that came before him, employing this talent with the grace of a slithering serpent.

His predatory instincts will combine the stealth of a lion, the speed of an eagle, the strength of a bear, and the sting of a scorpion. With peace as his weapon of choice, he will destroy many and actually be able to convince the masses it was for the global good. His knowledge of the Bible will be rich but he will purposely misquote the Word of God in blasphemy, eventually using Scripture to point to himself as god incarnate. He will for a time, be able to reign in the fluctuating world markets and the earth will breath a great sigh of relief under his yoke, accepting his plans to change laws and times as though he alone could bring the salvation nations seek from famine, drought, natural disasters and widespread disease and hunger. He will make people believe in their ability to bring about unity and prosperity with his vision for a final global utopia and in his arrogance and hardness of heart, he will use his influence to control heads of state and religious leaders, causing the powers that be to strive for a hate free world where all sexual types, religions, races, nations and kingdoms come together as one...except for those hateful and intolerant Christians who will come to Christ after the rapture.

War and Tribulation

After the Bride of Christ, the church, is snatched away in the Rapture, and the Antichrist rises, there is a period of seven years of great natural and unnatural calamities. This time is called the Tribulation. Over the next few weeks we will be looking at this time in detail. But, there is one event that most of us believe will happen in the first years following the Rapture.

If the Antichrist is to rise from the reconstituted Roman Empire, what about the countries in the area that are not part of that group?

Ezekiel 38 through 39 tells of a future invasion of Israel by a vast coalition of nations that surround it. With the nation of Israel now a reality, the stage seems set for the war that will usher in the tribulation and the rise of the Antichrist; a war that will end with the destruction of Israel's enemies by God Himself, and lead to the signing of a peace treaty with the Antichrist.

Ezekiel 38:1-8 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, 2 Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince of (Or *Magog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech*) Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him, 3 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal: 4 And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts [of armour, even] a great company [with] bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords: 5 Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them; all of them with shield and helmet: 6 Gomer, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his bands: [and] many people with thee. 7 Be thou prepared, and prepare for thyself, thou, and all thy company that are

assembled unto thee, and be thou a guard unto them. 8 After many days thou shalt be visited: in the latter years thou shalt come into the land [that is] brought back from the sword, [and is] gathered out of many people, against the mountains of Israel, which have been always waste: but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

The Hebrew word 'rosh' in verse 3 is identified with Russia, 'Tubal' with Tbilisi or Tobolsk and 'Meshech' with Moscow, therefore Gog and Magog refers to Russia. This is one of the most commonly held views and is based on a different interpretation of the Hebrew word Rosh. Gog and Magog include the nations descending from Japheth: Russia, the Caucasus(Turkey), Iraq, and the Islamic republics of Central Asia. The coalition is an alliance of Arab nations, Muslim republics, Georgia, southern Russia and the Black sea area.

Genesis 10:1-2 Now these [are] the generations of the sons of Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth: and unto them were sons born after the flood.² The sons of Japheth; Gomer, and Magog, and Madai, and Javan, and Tubal, and Meshech, and Tiras.

During the Iran–Iraq War, the USSR supplied Saddam Hussein with large amounts of conventional arms. Ayatollah Khomeini deemed Islam principally incompatible with the communist ideals of the Soviet Union, leaving the secular Saddam as an ally of Moscow. After the war, especially with the fall of the USSR, **Tehran-Moscow relations witnessed a sudden increase in diplomatic and commercial relations**, and Iran soon even began purchasing weapons from Russia. By the mid 1990s, Russia had already agreed to continue work on developing Iran's Nuclear Program.

Below is a list of the nations that are listed in Ezekiel as Israel's last-days enemies:

The reasons God gives us for the enemies' invasion of Israel are further proof that the attack will be an Islamic invasion.

The reason God gives for the invasion in Ezekiel 38 is a desire by the coalition to cover the Jewish land and wipe them off the face of the earth. Urged on by a hatred of the Jewish people they will seek to destroy them and the nation of Israel. This is the stated goal today of almost every Islamic nation in the Middle East. The only nations not currently in a declared state of war with Israel are Egypt, Turkey, and Jordan, yet they would certainly be glad to see Israel eliminated if presented with a willing leader and an opportunity to rid the Middle East of Islam's archenemy.

The US will not defend Israel. According to the Bible, Israel must stand alone ... with God. For when this coming war *does* finally start, the United States (for reasons yet unknown) will be unable or unwilling to help Israel defend herself. Although the Bible warns the invading armies will be ultimately destroyed by God, it will be a devastating war for both Israel and the whole world.

The good news is that God wins. God will come against the invaders Himself and destroy them. Verses 19-20 say that there will be an earthquake so great that people all over the world will tremble. In the ensuing chaos, nations will begin to turn on each other. The confusion will lead to the largest case of death by friendly fire ever seen. Verse 22 of Ezekiel tells us that there will be plagues, torrents of rain, hailstones, and burning sulfur. Just as God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, he will destroy these invading forces. Once again, God will make it known to all the nations that He is the Lord. He will give the nations proof that He is the Holy One in Israel.

This war against Israel will pave the way for the Antichrist's military rule over the world and his demand that the world worship him as God. With Islam defeated and the Christian Church raptured, opposition to worshipping a man as God will be greatly reduced. Those who are left would have no army with which to mount much of a protest.

Ezekiel 38:15-23 And thou shalt come from thy place out of the north parts, thou, and many people with thee, all of them riding upon horses, a great company, and a mighty army: 16 And thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; **it shall be in the latter days**, and I will bring thee against my land, that the heathen may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes. 17 Thus saith the Lord GOD; [Art] thou he of whom I have spoken in old time by my servants the prophets of Israel, which prophesied in those days [many] years that I would bring thee against them? 18 And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, [that] my fury shall come up in my face. 19 For in my jealousy [and] in the fire of my wrath have I spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel; 20 So that the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep upon the earth, and all the men that [are] upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground. 21 And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord GOD: every man's sword shall be against his brother. 22 And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that [are] with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone. 23 Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

Iran and Iraq in Bible Prophecy

The huge demonstrations protesting the election issues in Iran put that country on the front pages of every newspaper. For nearly two weeks, demonstrations have raged. Early on, some said that they didn't know what would happen as to whether the protests would succeed in overthrowing the regime, but most recognized that the endgame was a foregone conclusion: the regime has the tanks, the guns, and the military.

Based on the prophecies in the Bible, and based on my own belief that we are entering the last days, my view is that Iran will become more hostile and violent as it is increasingly isolated in the Western world. Furthermore, my view is that it will engage in an increasingly close alliance with Russia and with other Islamic Arab and African states.

It is important to realize that the Iranian Constitution, (Article Five) is inherently apocalyptic in nature. The still-revered Ayatollah Khomeini in 1979 proclaimed that the basis for Iran's constitution and its government would be the authority of the Hidden (or Twelfth) Imam. This apocalyptic figure has been called the 'expected one,' (al—Muntazar), the 'promised one' (al—Mahdi'), or the 'hidden one,' (al—Mustatir) in the Shi'a tradition.

The threats of impending destruction of Israel and even of war against the United States have been issued in the name of this Twelfth Imam, or Mahdi, who will (according to Iranian/Shi'a Islam) come in the last days. According to the tradition, the Hidden Imam was taken into hiding by Allah and kept there until he reappears in the last days to purify the ummah and take the world for Islam.

Ummah is an Arabic word meaning "community" or "nation". It is commonly used to mean either the collective nation of states, or the whole Arab world. In the context of Islam, the word is used to mean the "Community of the Believers," and thus the whole Muslim world.

Mahmoud Ahmadinejad and many others in the Iranian leadership passionately hold to the coming of the Hidden Imam. According to the Shia and Sunni versions of the Islamic eschatology the Mahdi is the prophesied redeemer of Islam who will stay on earth seven, nine, or nineteen years (depending on the interpretation) before the coming of the day, "Day of the Resurrection" or "Day of the Standing"). Muslims believe the Mahdi will rid the world of error, injustice and tyranny alongside Jesus. Shiite orthodoxy has it that humans are powerless to encourage the Twelfth Imam to return. However, in Iran a group called the Hojjatieh believe that humans can stir up chaos and violence to encourage him – even force him – to return. And Ahmadinejad is at least a former member, and quite likely a current member of this sect. When Ahmadinejad became president, \$17 million was spent on the Jamkaran mosque, which is central to the Hojjatieh movement. And it is even more frightening when such a man sitting as President of Iran claims to have a direct link to God.

Ahmadinejad shares with Trotsky, the Russian philosopher, an apocalyptic world outlook. He favors direct action in pursuit of a permanent Islamic revolution that will pave the way for the return of the Hidden Imam, pave it with blood, sweat and tears. Indeed he'd like to speed things up and implicitly he hopes to achieve this by twisting the arm of the Almighty. Muqtada al-Sadr named his Iraqi insurgent force **The Mahdi Army**, in reference to the Shia messiah.

So when one considers Iran, under such leadership, to be dedicated to the acquisition of nuclear weapons after stating that Israel should be "wiped out from the map" – and with the current Ayatollah Khamenei stating that Israel is a "cancerous tumor" on the verge of collapse – well, one should be very worried.

Wiping out Israel in a fiery blaze of atomic glory would indeed be a way to create the holocaust that would prompt the return of the long-awaited Hidden Imam (if anything *ever* could). Clearly Jews understand this, as 1 in 4 would seriously consider leaving the country if Iran succeeds in acquiring nuclear weapons. Given that such an event would literally mean the end of the state of Israel even if Iran didn't nuke them, Israel has little choice but to attack Iran's nuclear capability (since – clearly – no one else will).

Such an event, of hated Israel swooping into an Islamic country to destroy their Russian-built nuclear facilities, would itself be a likely cataclysmic event. Do you even dare to imagine how the Islamic world would react? And realize that just such an event is very likely coming – and coming all-too soon.

Now Vice President Joe Biden predicted that Barack Obama would be “tested” by an “international crisis” that would test his mettle. Joe Biden quickly turned his discussion of this international crisis and Barack Obama's seeming poor handling of said crisis to politics and the hopes of Democrats. But Iran obtaining nuclear weapons won't be about politics; **it will be about Armageddon.**

Joel Rosenberg, the author of Dead Heat and other prophetic novels, has done a thorough study of the Book of Ezekiel and of the Bible. He learned that one day, according to the Bible, a massive army under the leadership of Russia and many of its former republics (Magog) and Iran (Persia) and consisting of many countries that are today Islamic [e.g. "Cush" (modern-day Sudan and Ethiopia); "Put" (modern-day Libya); "Gomer" (modern-day Turkey); "Beth-togarmah" (modern-day Armenia); and many peoples "along the mountains of Israel" (modern-day Lebanon and possibly Syria)] would form an “exceedingly great army” that would one day attack Israel.

What Rosenberg noted was the absence of two countries: Egypt and Babylon (i.e. Iraq). Egypt had been a perennial enemy of Israel until 1973, when Egypt alone in all the Arab/Muslim world forged a historic peace treaty with the state of Israel. That left Iraq. Rosenberg asked himself, “How could a nation like Iraq, under the leadership of someone like Saddam Hussein, NOT participate in this mega-colossal-last-days attack on Israel? Rosenberg concluded that Saddam Hussein **would not refrain** from such an attack. And that meant that Saddam Hussein would have to go. And so, **nine months** before the 9/11 attack, Rosenberg in his “fiction” created a scenario in which terrorists flew a plane in a kamikaze attack, and the United States took out the Iraqi regime and replaced it with a stable Western-friendly government.

And because the Bible is the true Word of an all-knowing God who knows the end from the beginning as revealed through His prophets, the scenario laid out by Joel Rosenberg turned out to be eerily true. It wasn't a “lucky guess”; it

was based upon the God who had revealed the last days to an inspired prophet named Ezekiel some 2,600 years ago.

Thus we have Iraq, its tyrant who had filled mass graves with the bodies of at least 400,000 of his own people, overthrown and a stable democracy growing in his place. And we have Iran, a country strongly allied with Russia; a country bent on acquiring nuclear weapons; a country that has announced its intent on the destruction of Israel; a country under the leadership of men who in all likelihood believe in establishing a future by an act of violent apocalypse. Two countries on two very different paths. And both paths known to God 2,600 years ago.

I see a whole new world. One in which the mere mention of God could find you separated from your head. I perceive that this time is much closer than most think.
